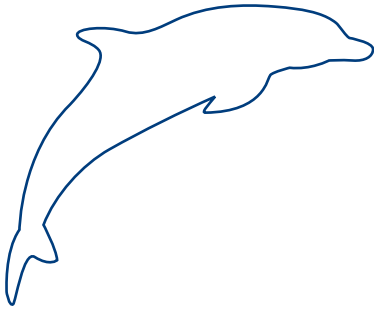

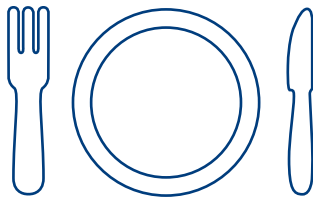

School dinners encourage children living in poor communities to go to school and learn to read and write. Now there's food for thought.

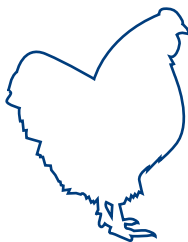

There's nothing wet about this gift, it'll help provide a family in Ethiopia with clean water for a year. This gift solves the immediate problem of poor health in the community.

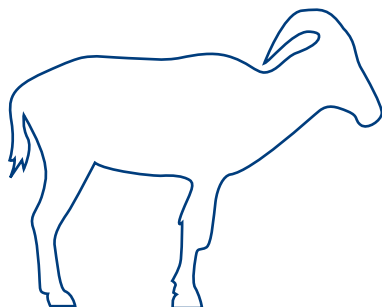
